



Public Information Meeting for Cuyahoga River Old Channel Sediment Cleanup Project



You are invited to a public meeting about the Cuyahoga River Old Channel (CROC) sediment cleanup. This multi-phase dredging project involves the removal of ~100,000 cubic yards of contaminated sediment from the CROC and transporting by barges for proper disposal in a confined disposal facility. The U.S. Environmental Protection Agency, in partnership with the Port of Cleveland, Northeast Ohio Regional Sewer District, Ohio Environmental Protection Agency, and Ohio Lake Erie Commission, is holding the meeting to provide the public with the opportunity to learn more about the cleanup and provide feedback. The meeting will focus on the initial phase of the project involving the construction of a containment basin for sediment disposal. Agency representatives will be available to answer questions.
